
**OUR OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES**

## Needs in India

- Triaging of symptomatic patients
- Infrastrucyre requirement for moderate and severe diseases
- Shortage for sources of oxygen; Oxygen plants, cylinders & concentrators
- All hospitals should mobilize additional resources including masks, gloves and personal protection equipment.
- Health-care professionals should be trained in Infection control and Use of PPE
- Care of affected persons and care in emergency situations
- Hospitals must procure sufficient numbers of ventilators and high flow oxygen masks in preparation for future requirements.
- All hospitals must ensure that they have adequate trained manpower and resource pools for ventilator/ ICU care.
