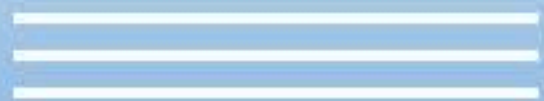

Needs in India

- **Triaging of symptomatic patients**
- **Infrastructure requirement for moderate and severe diseases**
- **Shortage for sources of oxygen; Oxygen plants, cylinders & concentrators**
- **All hospitals should mobilize additional resources including masks, gloves and personal protection equipment.**
- **Health-care professionals should be trained in Infection control and Use of PPE**
- **Care of affected persons and care in emergency situations**
- **Hospitals must procure sufficient numbers of ventilators and high flow oxygen masks in preparation for future requirements.**
- **All hospitals must ensure that they have adequate trained manpower and resource pools for ventilator/ ICU care.**

- **Experienced in the area of monitoring.**



What CMAI Network can offer for Covid-19 Response

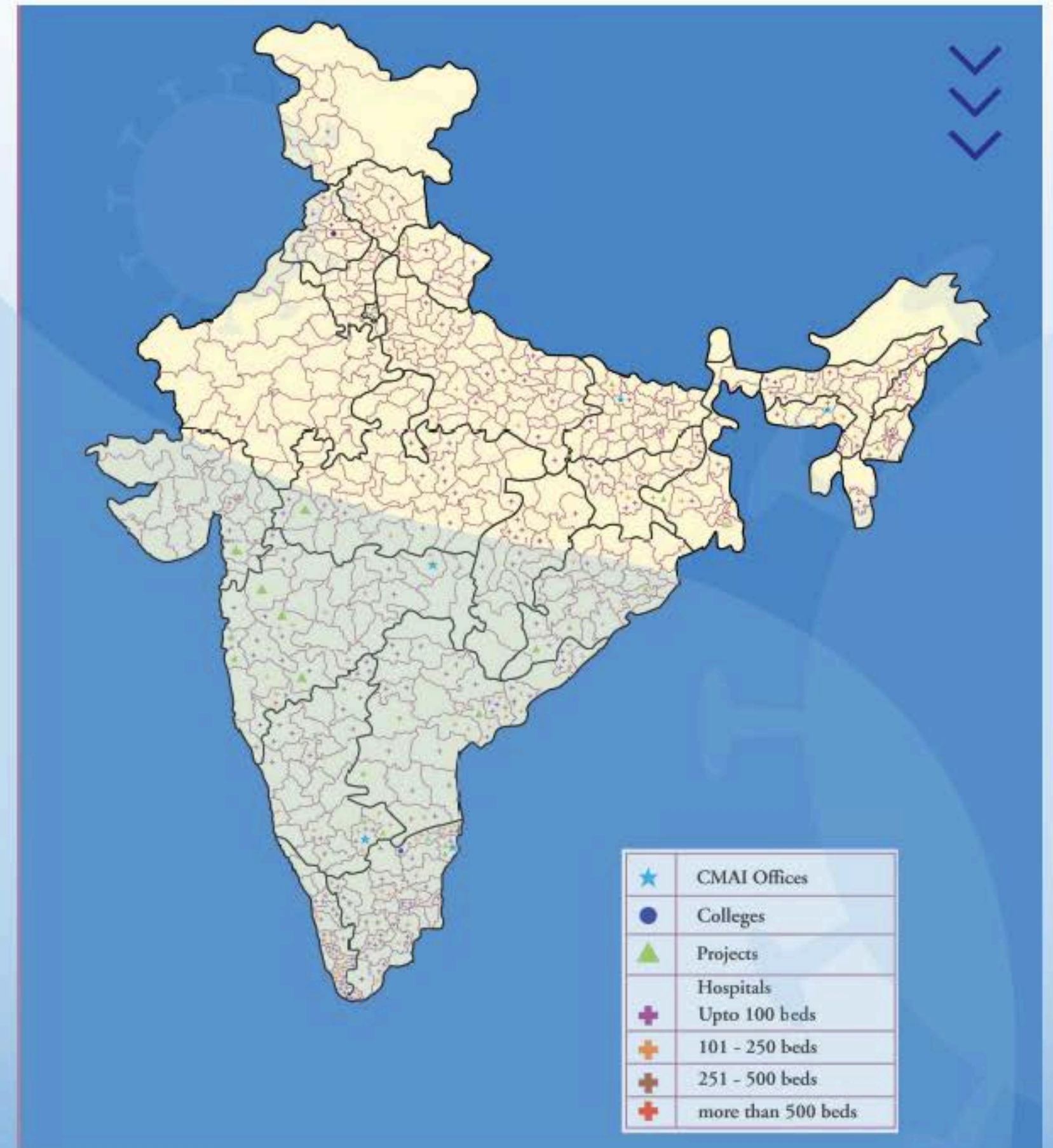

Challenges faced by CMAI Network hospitals

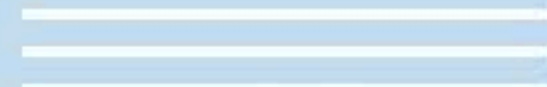
- **Lack of PPEs for the healthcare professional**
