Course details

Duration of the Course

- 3-month course with 3 Contact classes
- Orientation programme : 2 days
- Exposure visit : 3 days
- Final Workshop and Assessment: 5 days
- TOTAL 10 days = 80 hours

Periodic assessment and feedback will be carried out to help nurses to enhance their skills.

Certificate shall be awarded at the successful completion of the programme

The course may be offered in multiple centres across the country.

Methodology of Learning

Adult Learning Methods

Modules: Learning & facilitator modules

Distance Education with practical related assignments to be undertaken between workshops, workbooks etc, with hard copy and e-options available.

An ideal batch will be 16 – 24 participants.

Observational visits to institutions of excellence.

Workshops will be held monthly in respective regions for a period of 2-3 days

Nurse leaders are the ones who lead professionals not just manage workers. They need to develop them and create a healthy work environment. For years, the development of nurses in this vital role has been neglected and many nurses have made the transition to ward sister or being 'Incharge of a ward' through a process of trial and error. Studies have proved that effective leadership is highly related to retention and satisfaction of staff.
